


## Public Affairs and Information Technology Course

August 24-26, 2004  
Oak Ridge, Tennessee

The Public Affairs and Information Technology Course is a three-day training for CSEPP public information officers and other emergency responders that demonstrates ways to enhance Joint Information Center/Joint Information System and other emergency operations through the use of technology.

### Session 1: 21st Century Technical Solutions

Explore how to improve functional emergency response integration through the use of technology such as web-based, computerized status boards and handheld, wireless applications.



### Session 2: Working With the Web

Use the web to create, revise, coordinate and broadcast emergency public information during an event.

### Session 3: 21st Century Media Releases

Learn to develop technology-assisted media releases from remote locations.

### Session 4: Technology-Assisted Briefings and News Conferences

Explore techniques and technologies that can simplify development, coordination, and delivery of messages during an event.

### Session 5: Using PDAs to Enhance Joint Information Center/Joint Information System Emergency Coordination Functions

Use the PDA to connect with other members of response teams during an event.

### Session 6: PowerPlay

Use PowerPlay, a dynamic and highly interactive format, to integrate concepts demonstrated in previous sessions.
